FOR ADMISSION OFFICERS: CLASS OF 2025

We offer a total of 12 Advanced Placement (AP), 14 Honors and 2 Dual Enrollment courses. Our limitation on the number of advanced courses students may take remain in place and are scheduled based on placement and counseling: one honors course in the 8th grade, four honors courses in the freshman year, one AP and three honors in the sophomore year and no restrictions in the junior and senior years.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA AND PROCESS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Applications are accepted from 6th grade boys enrolled in parochial, independent, public, or homeschool programs. Additionally, qualified transfer students can apply for admission to 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades.

Applications are evaluated on academic performance, co-curricular involvement, and academic recommendations.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

GENERAL:

At Saint Stanislaus, academically talented students follow a rigorous college preparatory curriculum designed to challenge and prepare them for higher education. The academic program requires students to complete seven academic classes in both the fall and spring terms, ensuring a comprehensive and well-rounded education.

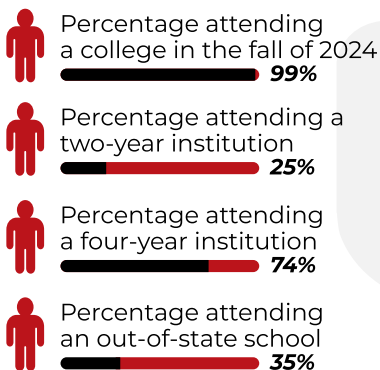
